Purpose and Responsibilities:

Our **School Age Educator** will work collaborately with a team of School Age and/or Early Childhood Educators to plan, develop and deliver daily activities, that support and promote the health and development of children 4.5-12 years of age, using the Reggio Emilia approach to learning alongside the BC Early Learning Framework. Other responsibilities include developing strong relationships and communication with children, families and colleagues, and implementing high standards of care and supervision that promote the well-being of all children. School Age Programs are provided at a variety of locations such as childcare facilities, schools and community centres, generally after school hours (2:00 -6:00 PM) but extended programming will be required for any school closure days. Additional hours maybe available in child care programs. And other related duties as required.

Qualifications Required:

- At least 19 years of age
- ECE an asset. Or a successful completion of one or more courses, of at least 20 hours duration in child development, guidance, health and safety or nutrition
- First Aid certificate
