Responsibilities:

The ECE/IT's will be responsible for the provision of quality care and education for the children in our Infant-Toddler and 3-5 Programs. The individual will guide and work with the team members throughout the daily operations to ensure children are provided with proper care and activities that reflect our Reggio Emilia philosophy. The individual will also participate in the documentation, the programming and the classroom environment creation to support children's holistic development and well-being based on the BC Early Learning Framework and Reggio Emilia approach.

Other responsibilities include developing strong communication and relationships with children, families and colleagues. The ECE/IT's work closely with other educators, Team Leads, and the Early Years and School Age Coordinators in creating a positive community environment for children, families and staff.

- Experience working with special needs children is an asset
- Willingness to provide an emergent program based on the principles of the Reggio Emilia Approach and the BC ELF.
